Packing List

- Keep in mind that the average temperature for the Osa is 90°F and extremely humid.
- There is a large sink for washing clothes at El Ceibo, if you wish to do it yourself.
 Or you can pay Marlene to do laundry for you. (Cost is per pound)
- When entering a school, church or formal business, it is respectful to wear something that covers your knees and shoulders. Dress conservatively, yet lightweight!
- Packing for 1 week or 10 weeks does not make much of a difference!
- Check with airlines (international and domestic) on weight allowance
- Bring a daypack along with a larger suitcase or backpack
